- Hospice Society Volunteers provide compassionate, supportive care.

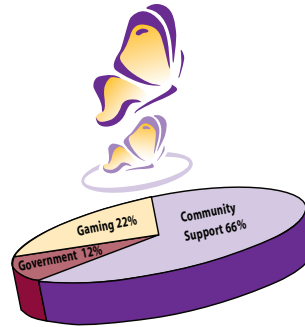
- Hospice Society Volunteers visit clients and their families providing companionship to patients, as well as support and respite for caregivers.

TYPES OF GIFTS

General Gift

Make a donation in your name to help support the Chilliwack Hospice Society's programs and services.

Memorial Gift

A gift in memory of a loved one is a special way to support Hospice. It is often a thoughtful remembrance in place of funeral flowers. Many people make annual contributions in memory of loved ones. The Chilliwack Hospice Society will send a personalized card acknowledging your gift.

Planned Giving
